- Sound understanding of existing development concerns in Maldives, the effect of climate change on development, and good understanding of coastal zone management issues;
- Extensive business and information exchange network with national and international institutions involved in local and international studies of climate change, in general, and adaptation, in particular
- Excellent inter-personal, verbal, written communication and negotiating skills
- Previous work experience in the country on issues relevant to the project
- Ability and willingness to travel within and outside the Maldives
- Demonstrable skills in office computer use - word processing, spread sheets etc.
- Proven track record of project management and project team experience working with government, NGOs, and other key stakeholders in Maldives
