1 Introduction

The Government of Maldives wishes to host the Network Meeting of the South Asia National Ozone Officers from 21st to 25th May 2023. This meeting will be held in-person.

The main objective of the meeting is to facilitate network countries to share experiences/good practices in various areas under the Montreal Protocol, further discuss the implementation of Conclusion and Recommendations from the Joint Network Meeting in October 2022, including issues to be considered at the upcoming Montreal Protocol related meetings and implications from recent meetings, refrigeration and air conditioning (RAC) servicing sector, preparation of Kigali HFC implementation plan (KIPs), cold chain sector, energy efficiency, refrigerant management, and other cross-cutting issues such as gender mainstreaming and CAP services, etc.

In this regard the Ministry of Environment, Climate Change & Technology (MECCT) is seeking the services of a conference facility or, four star or more hotel/resort in Male' or nearby for provision of conference facilities, catering and transfer services for hosting the above mentioned workshop.

2 Scope of work

The scope of the assignment will include the following:

4 Evaluation Criteria

4.1 Pre-Evaluation

- a) Pre-Evaluation will be carried out based on the documentation requirement prior to the Final Evaluation. Pre-Evaluation determines if bidder is substantially responsive to the terms of this ToR as specified below;
 - Bidder has the financial capacity to undertake the works required in the TOR. Refer to Annex 2 for details.
 - Bidder meets all requirements identified under Section 2 and 3. Scope of Work and Venue hire and catering.
- b) Substantially non-responsive bids at this pre-evaluation stage will be rejected from further evaluation.
- c) Evaluation will be undertaken for substantially responsive bids identified at preevaluation stage

4.2 Evaluation

The proposals which fulfill the pre-evaluation requirements would be qualified to this stage after being assessed in pre-evaluation.

Financial Score:

The formula for determining the financial scores is the following:

Sf=100 * Fm / F, in which Sf is the financial score, Fm is the <u>lowest price</u> and F is the price of the proposal under consideration.

Financial Situation evaluation

To be eligible the financial statements of the bidding party must show, minimum annual turnover of MVR 300,000.00, for the year 2021,2020 and 2019. (Submit Form FIN-1 Annual Turnover)

(OR)

To be eligible the financial statements of the bidding party must show, Minimum value of MVR 300,000.00, for liquid asset, for the year 2021 ,2020 and 2019. – (Submit Form FIN -2: Financial Situation)

(OR)

Business entities that have not completed one year (from the date of business registration to date of bid announcement) are required to submit the bank statement of the business's bank account.

(bank statement should be from the date of account opening to date of bid announcement). To be eligible the business's bank statement must show a credit balance of minimum MVR 300,000.00

(OR)

If bidding party is unable to meet any of the above requirement they shall submit 'Line of Credit Letter' As per the template in fin form 4. Credit limit shall be no less than MVR 300,000.00 – (Submission Form Fin -4: Line of Credit Letter)

Selection Criteria of Regional Based business and MSME business

Below MVR 2,500,000

Among bidders who pass the technical and financial evaluation, Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME's) will be assessed accordingly:

The bidder with the highest ranking with a proposed price that doesn't exceed 15% of the price of the bidder with the overall highest ranking will be awarded.

Among bidders who pass the technical and financial evaluation if there is no bidder as described in (a), bidders who belong to the same island as the project is carried out will be assessed accordingly:

The bidder with the highest ranking with a proposed price that doesn't exceed 10% of the price of the bidder with the overall highest ranking will be awarded.

Among bidders who pass the technical and financial evaluation if there is no bidder as described in (a) and (b), bidders who belong to the same atoll as the project is being carried out is checked and assessed accordingly:

The bidder with the highest ranking with a proposed price that doesn't exceed 5% of the price of the bidder with the overall highest ranking will be awarded.

Among bidders who pass the technical and financial evaluation if there is no bidder as described in (a), (b) and (c), all Maldivian bidders will be checked and assessed accordingly.

The bidder with the highest ranking with the lowest proposed price will be awarded

Among bidders who pass the technical and financial evaluation if there is no bidder as described in (a), (b), (c) and (d) all bidders will be assessed accordingly.

The bidder with the highest ranking with the lowest proposed price will be awarded

Criteria on classifying regional based business

Check the bidders permanent address, if the bidder is a sole proprietorship

Check the island to which the business is registered, if the bidder is not a sole proprietorship

The bidder will be considered as a business working in one certain area, as per (a) and (b) accordingly:

If the bidder is a sole proprietorship, the bidder's registered permanent address as of 1st January of the year the invitation for bid was issued will be considered OR

If the business had been registered before the year in which the invitation for bid was issued, the island to which the business was registered as of 1st January of the year the invitation for bid was issued will be considered

OR

If the business had been registered within the year in which the invitation for bid was issued, the island to which the business was first registered will be considered.

Additional Information

Ministry of Environment, Climate Change and technology has overall responsibility for the management of the contract and contractual reporting obligations.

Documents and data provided by the government for the purpose of this assessment which is not of public nature shall be considered confidential and should not be disclosed to any other party.

All outputs and materials produced as part of this TOR shall be handed over to the NOU at the end of the contract and will become the sole property of Ministry of Environment, Climate Change and Technology.

Obtaining any necessary visa and documents are the responsibility of the proponent. MECCT will only provide a visa facilitation letter if necessary.

For the workshop and trainings: invitations, catering and venue will be financed directly by the project. This cost should NOT be included in the price quotation.

For domestic travel: land and sea travel (as per the schedule provided and agreed upon) will be directly financed by the project. This does not include the DSA.
