## Terms of Reference for Procurement Officer

## 1. Introduction

The Project "Strengthening Low Carbon Energy Island Strategies Project (LCEI)" is implemented by Ministry of Environment and Energy (MEE) in association with UNEP through funding received from the Global Environment Facility (GEF) and aims to reduce greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions through energy efficiency in the building sector. The project will focus on increasing energy efficiency in the building sector by developing appropriate policies, guidelines and standards. The project also include implementation of a monitoring and assessment system for the energy efficiency interventions, support financing of building related energy efficiency programmes, demonstration of energy efficiency and technology in public buildings, capacity building for various sectors related to energy efficiency in the building sector.

## 2. Objective

The objective of this assignment is to support the procurement activities being undertaken for the LCEI project by the Ministry of Environment and Energy with the responsibility for ensuring compliance with both the Maldives procurement regulations and the donor agencies guidelines on procurement and selection of consultants and goods.

## 3. Overall Responsibility

The overall responsibility of the Procurement Officer include, but are not limited to the following:

- Work in coordination with the project team and advise them on procurement issues and assume responsibility of all major procurement of the projects.
- Prepare and/or review requests for Expression of Interest (EOI), Tender documents, Request for Proposals (RFP), Contract agreements for goods, works, consultants and non-consultant services in accordance with the work plan.
- Conduct/Coordinate all evaluations and negotiations pertaining to procurement of goods, works and consultants.
- Provide guidance on Consultant short-listing, and bid and proposal evaluations;
- Any other procurement related tasks assigned by the Project Manager.











## 4. Reporting requirement

The Procurement Officer is expected to work closely with the LCEI project management unit established in Climate Change Department under the Ministry of Environment and Energy and will report directly to LCEI Project Manager.

## 5. Qualification and Experience

- 1. Minimum undergraduate degree
- Must have professional work experience of at least one (1) year in procurement of consultants, works and goods; and have had substantial management/Supervisory responsibilities pertaining to procurement.
- 3. Sound understanding of principles underlying good procurement practices and international agencies' procurement guidelines will be an added advantage.
- Sound understanding of Government's procurement Regulations/Act will be an added advantage.
- 5. Specialized knowledge of and significant experience in all substantive areas/aspects of procurement (e.g. procurement of goods; various forms of construction contracts; selection/contracting of consultant services under various methods; preparation of bidding/contract documents for the international procurement of goods, works, services; public procurement policies; practices) will be an added advantage.
- Knowledge and understanding of technical, commercial and legal aspects of procurement of donor - financed projects would be an added advantage.
- Should have strong leadership, management and communication skills in presenting, discussing
  and resolving difficult issues and have ability to work efficiently and effectively with a
  multidisciplinary team.

Track record of candidate's civil services conduct and performance will be considered. The successful individual must be willing to work for extended periods without direct supervision.

The successful candidate must understand the objectives and delivery mechanisms of the projects portfolio. He/she must be willing to work in a team, be flexible to emerging or changing conditions, and undertake initiative in his/her broad field of actions.
