Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Report for GA. Nilandhoo

1. INTRODUCTION

The Ministry of Environment and Energy intends to procure the services of a consultant to Develop the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Report for the establishment of an Island Waste Management Centre (IWMC) at GA. Nilandhoo, Maldives.

2. OBJECTIVE

The specific objective of this assignment is to ensure that the construction of IWMC at GA. Nilandhoo is in compliance with the existing relevant laws and regulations.

3. SCOPE OF WORKS

The consultant will produce the EIA report through a consultative process.

Consultation shall be made with but not necessarily limited to; Ministry of Environment and Energy, Island Council and where necessary community consultation shall also be undertaken.

The tasks to be undertaken by the consultant under this Terms of Reference are to be managed in close collaboration with Waste Management and Pollution Control Department of the Ministry of Environment and Energy, and include but are not necessarily limited to the following:

- Undertake the application process for the EIA works of the assignment
- Undertake the scoping or screening wherever applicable for the assignment
- Undertake field data collection survey and develop the EIA report as per the approved
- Terms of Reference by EPA after the scoping meeting
- Submit the final EIA Report to EPA and get approval/decision statement
- Undertake submission and provide any clarifications where as necessary to the submitted EIA
- Accommodate any request by EPA for any additional information regarding the submitted EIA report.

4. SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

The following documents shall be submitted for the bids to be considered sufficiently responsive.

- a) CV of the Individual (Inclusive of a copy of the National Identity Card)
 - b) List of EIA completed by the individual within the past 3 years along with valid official reference letters
 - c) Proposed equipment and methodology of works
 - d) Cost breakdown of major activities. The total cost shall be clearly indicated.
 - e) [If the Individual is subject to GST as per MIRA Regulations and Guidelines, the GST Registration Certificate]

Only the past assignments that have official reference letters will be considered during evaluation.

The Consultant should submit full CV’s of the proposed staff highlighting the criteria given below.

a. EIA Consultant

Bachelor’s Degree in Environmental Engineering/Environmental Science/Environmental Management with minimum 05 years’ experience in conducting Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA). Tertiary certification will be an added advantage. Experience in conducting EIA for waste management related projects will be given preference. The consultant should hold a permanent EIA

license and his/her EIA license copy shall be submitted along with a dated letter stating his/her association with the bidding party.
