The Government of the Republic of Maldives through the Ministry of Environment (MoE) is implementing Maldives Clean Environment Project (MCEP) financed through grant aid from the World Bank's International Development Association (IDA), and intends to apply part of the proceeds to a consultancy assignment for the formulation of an overarching waste and resource management policy and strategy for the Maldives, as part of the GoM's efforts to strengthen waste and resource management sector in the country.

The main objective of this assignment is to formulate an integrated national waste and resource management strategy with next step and gap filling policy recommendations in line with the government's Strategic Action Plan (SAP). The strategy should also make recommendations for an associated implementation plan (short, medium and long-term) for waste and resource management in the Maldives taking into account stakeholder feedback, goals and targets, outcomes and performance targets and cost-effectiveness. Recommendations and activities should have a clearly defined baseline relating to the current situation, existing policy framework, and stages of implementation in the Maldives based on capacity, funding, and timing requirements. The Consultant will also be required to propose changes to the draft bill on Waste Management, in line with the updated policy and the strategy developed under this assignment.
